# THE ECLIPSE SCHEDULE

A total solar eclipse happens when the moon is closest to the Earth and is directly between the earth and the sun. A total solar eclipse happens somewhere in the world every 18-months, but it only happens in the same place approximately every 375 years. The last time our area experienced a total solar eclipse was in the 1800s.



- 12:16 p.m.: Partial Eclipse begins (Glasses on!)
- 1:34 p.m.: Total Eclipse begins and lasts for 3 minutes. Darkness for 3 minutes (Glasses off!)
- 1:38 p.m.: Totality ends and Partial Eclipse Resumes (Glasses on!)
- 2:57 p.m.: Partial Eclipse ends

**PLEASE NOTE:** Typical check-out time is at 11 a.m. -- however, if your check-out day is **MONDAY 4/8**, we want you to enjoy the eclipse! So we've extended all Monday check-outs until 3:30 p.m. If you later decide you'd like to add that night to your stay, please let us know by 3:30 that day.

Traffic is anticipated to be very heavy in the area immediately after this, so plan accordingly.

## PLANNING AHEAD:

We recommend that you do your grocery shopping ahead of time, on the way in, or close to home, as high-demand is anticipated here.

But our local grocery is **HEB**, with two locations in the area.

**Walgreens, CVS, and Dollar General** are nearby as well.

## TIPS:

- Bring a Cooler to keep out on your porch for that extra stock.
- There are several grills available around the property but only suites with kitchenettes (and campers) have dishware and utensils. If you plan to cook, bring disposable plates and those other necessities with you.

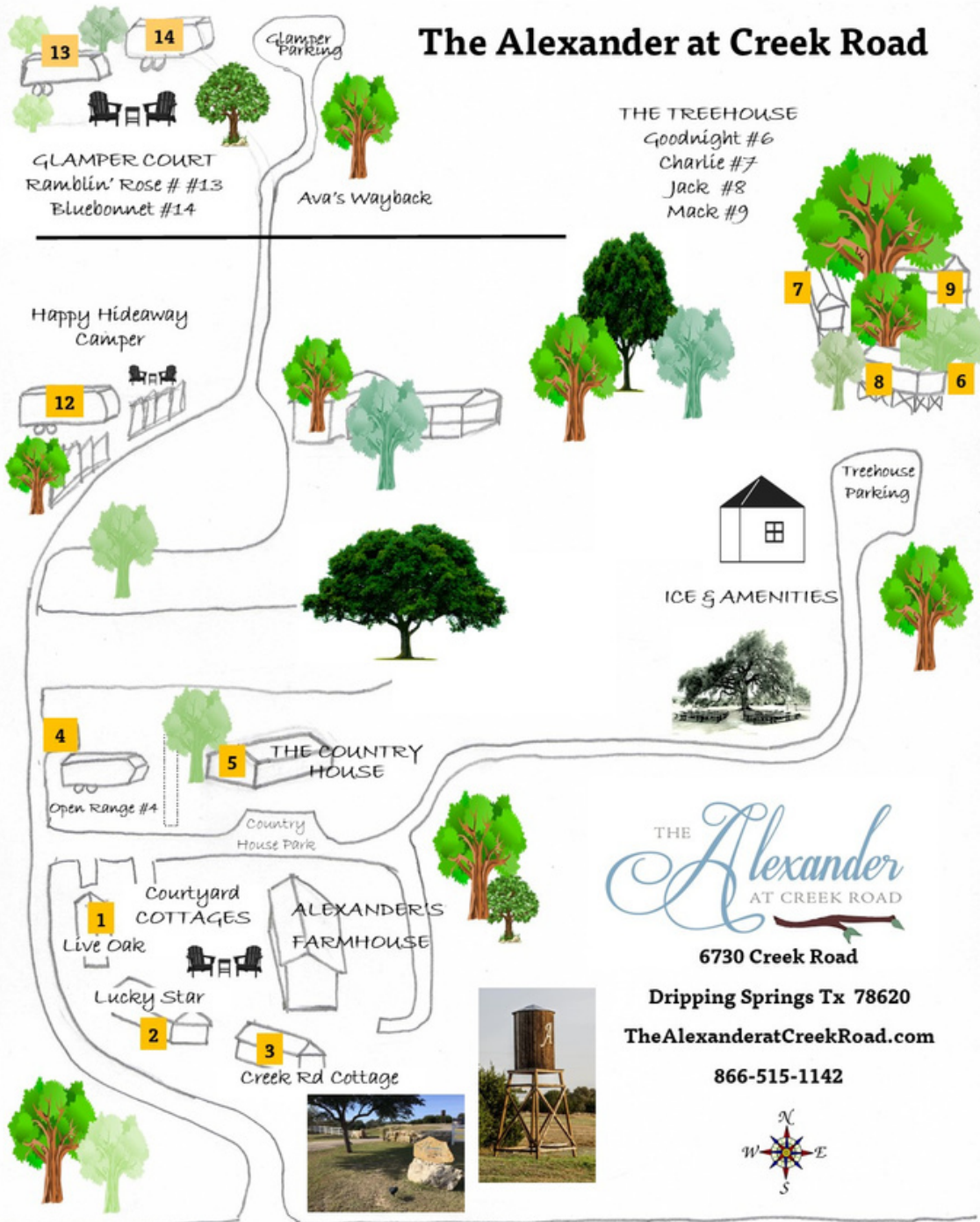
